Breaking Down Broadway

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
Are you interested in interpreting theatre and not sure where and how to get started?

work on the script with your team.


We will work with a video of the show in order to apply new interpreting strategies to create a rich performance interpretation.

- 5. Apply effective team interpreting strategies in a theatrical setting.
- 6. Produce an interpretation of a musical at a final performance.
